

# **SOUTH CAROLINA I-77 ALLIANCE REGION** | DAILY POPULATION GROWTH: +35 PEOPLE

Located between the two major metropolitan areas of Charlotte and Columbia, with a combined population exceeding 3.5 million people, our location is one of the greatest assets the I-77 corridor can offer new and expanding companies. With access to two labor sheds of roughly 1.2 million people each coupled with the capacity to reach 145 million people within a single day's drive, the I-77 Region is primed for vast economic growth well into the future.

Companies from around the world have located to the I-77 region, drawn in by the mix of big-city conveniences, small-town charm and an endless array of recreation and entertainment.

Pair that with sunny, warm weather, plus a low cost of living and a wealth of housing options, and you will start to envision why almost 1 million people call this area home.


## **TWO MAJOR AIRPORTS** Charlotte Douglas International Airport + Columbia Metropolitan Airport

Flanked between two major commercial airports, the I-77 Region is adjacent to the Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT) and is home to the Columbia Metropolitan Airport (CAE). Ranked the 5th busiest airport in the world offering nonstop access to more than 160 domestic and international destinations, CLT oversees over 700 daily departures and landings and is served by seven domestic carriers and three foreign flag carriers. At CAE, their airline partners offer over 30 non-stop flights to 9 major airports in 8 cities, getting you almost anywhere in the world in one stop via one of their three carriers. CAE is also the Southeast regional cargo hub for UPS and is South Carolina's top cargo airport.

### **PORT OF CHARLESTON** | Fastest Growing Major Port in the United States


The Port of Charleston, which is directly accessible via I-26 and is located one hour from the 1-77 region, leads the nation as the fastest growing major port in the United States. In the midst of a major harbor deepening project, the Charleston Harbor will be the deepest on the East Coast with 52 feet of depth in the inner harbor and 54 feet of depth in the entrance channel.




**DAILY** POPULATION GROWTH COMBINED METRO AREAS (2020 – 2021)


### **REGIONAL LABOR SHEDS** | Civilian labor force of each labor shed: 1.3 million people
